

Trivia Night Rules

- 1) There will be 10 category rounds of 10 questions each, for a possible score of 100 points.
- 2) Teams receive one point for each correct answer. No “extra credit” or “half points” will be awarded. Each question only has one answer unless specified otherwise. There are no “trick questions”.
- 3) The use of cell phones, laptops, PDA’s or any other media device is prohibited. Please do not leave cell phones on your table. (Please leave the room if you must use your phone.)
- 4) *Tiebreaker* - At the beginning of round one, a tie breaker question with a numerical answer will be asked of all teams. In the event of a tie at the end of round ten, the tied team that has come closest to the correct answer will be announced as the winner.
- 5) Please write legibly. Unreadable answers will be marked wrong, however spelling does not count.
- 6) Please write your table number on the top of each of your answer sheets. Make sure your table number is visible.
- 7) *Mulligans* - Each table may purchase 10 mulligans (free answers) for \$10. Only one mulligan can be used per round.
- 8) At the end of each round, you will have two minutes to turn in your team’s answer sheet. If your team's answer sheet is not submitted within the allotted time, the team will receive no score for that round.
- 9) Please do not shout out any answers, correct or not, even as a joke. It can be very distracting.
- 10) The questions will be read twice, with 30 seconds between questions.
- 11) After all answer sheets are scored, the emcee will read the answers before continuing on to the next round.
- 12) Team totals will be posted and/or announced throughout the evening. If you have any questions about your score, alert a scorer immediately.
- 13) The decisions of the judge and organizers are final. However, if you would like to challenge an answer, a \$100 donation will be required.
